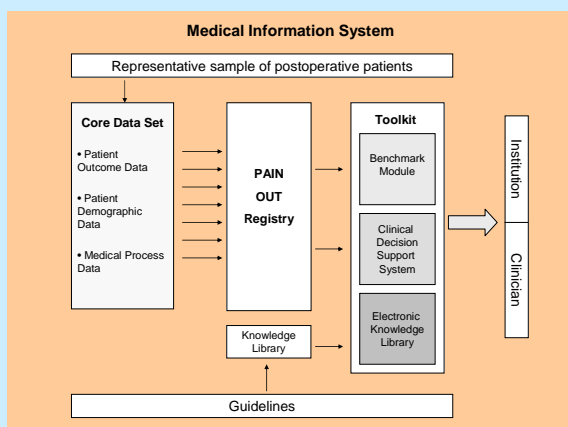


## Join the world's largest acute PAIN registry! ... and find out your rank

**PAIN OUT** aims at improving postoperative pain outcomes by use of 3 major tools:

- a Benchmark Module that feeds back outcomes interactively
- an Electronic Knowledge Library
- a Clinical Decision Support System



### Why should you join PAIN OUT?

- to identify shortcomings
- to be able to implement change management concepts by evaluating your own results
- to benefit from the research opportunities of the world's largest data base on post-op pain

### International extension

More than 60 hospitals take part in PAIN OUT (June 2013) and have collected more than 40,000 datasets by now. Close cooperation with the German Quips project (> 300,000 datasets).

### Requirements

- A fluently English speaking person for the data collection/input
- a computer with internet access
- your ethics committee's OK

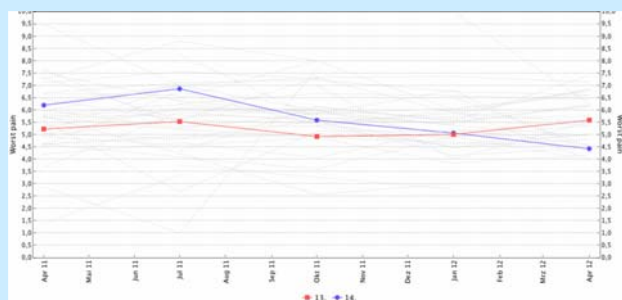
### How is it done?

- Collection of patient outcome data** (based on the International Pain Outcome questionnaire IPO) and **demographic and clinical data**

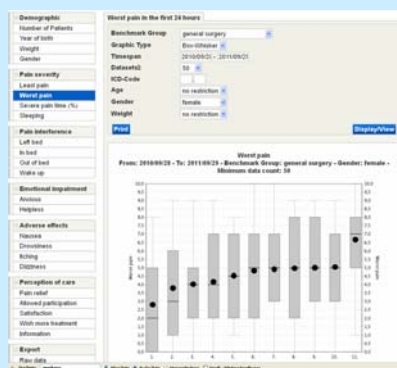
- Input of data into a web-based data entry mask**



- Feedback of results** via the benchmark server
